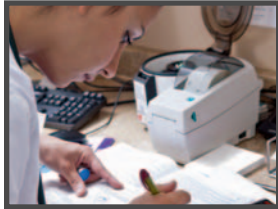


WHY SHOULD I SUPPORT

HOW DO I CONTRIBUTE TO THE BUCK-A-YEAR PROGRAM?

The guidelines of the Buck-A-Year program are quite simple: Take the number of years since you received your DVM and contribute that amount to become a bronze sponsor. Multiply that number by two to become a silver sponsor, by three to become a gold sponsor, and by five to become a platinum sponsor. Because the amount you contribute gradually increases over the time, this is the perfect program to begin early in your career.
