JODI LONG, DVM



Dr. Jodi Long grew up on small ranches in rural Oklahoma and Texas. She graduated with a bachelor of science degree in animal science from Stephen F. Austin State University in 1996 and a master of agriculture in 1997 and earned her Doctor of Veterinary Medicine from Texas A&M University in 2001. She practiced in Angleton, Texas, after graduation and began working at Bay Glen Animal Hospital in 2003 as an associate veterinarian, ultimately becoming a partner at Bay Glen in January 2008. Dr. Long is an active member of the Texas Veterinary Medical Association and has served on multiple committees including the TVMA Ethics and Grievance Committee. She is also a member of and former president of the Texas Academy of Veterinary Practice (TAVP).

LARRY KIMBERLIN, DVM, FAVD



Dr. Larry Kimberlin is a licensed Texas veterinarian with more than 25 years in mixed animal practice. His extensive experience includes treatment of pets, horses and livestock. Dr. Kimberlin is one of only a small number of Texas veterinarians certified to perform TPLO (Tibial Plateau Leveling Osteotomy) surgery to repair cruciate ligament ruptures in dogs. Dr. Kimberlin is also one of only 35 people certified by the International Veterinary Academy of Pain Management (IVAPM). He is also a fellow of the Academy of Veterinary Dentistry. (Admission to the Academy is awarded to veterinarians with a special interest in dentistry after completion of a two-year training program and passing the Academy exam.) Since 1987, only 80 veterinarians on four continents have become fellows of the Academy of Veterinary Dentistry. He holds membership in most of the major veterinary medical associations, including TVMA, in which he has served on the Ethics and Grievance Committee since 2009. He is a proud graduate of the Texas A&M University College of Veterinary Medicine.

Most files, misspelled names, wrong addresses and phone numbers... inaccuracies in medical records occur on a daily basis in veterinary clinics everywhere. Mistakes like these can lead to hours of searching, countless follow-up phone calls and major frustration. If confronted with a lawsuit or investigation by the state board, your records will be up for scrutiny. Will they pass the test?

This half-day seminar will help provide you with tips to manage your medical records with greater accuracy, confidentiality and efficiency.

Compliance requirements will be reviewed as pertaining to the Texas Veterinary Practice Act Rules of Professional Conduct. Ongoing maintenance recommendations to help keep your records on track and effective months and years later will also be covered.
